### GHC Volunteer Clinical Supervisor Agreement (for MFT Trainees)

As a volunteer clinical supervisor, you are helping meet a huge need for mental health counseling services in our community. Your commitment enables one MFT Trainee to provide counseling services to six clients per week. Eighty percent of GHC clients pay \$10 or less per session, making GHC one of the most affordable and accessible counseling services in our region. Your volunteer commitment is making this possible!

#### Duties and responsibilities:

- Provide individual clinical supervision to MFT Trainee for one-hour/week, per BBS requirements (day and time TBD by you and the trainee).
- Review bio-psycho-social assessment for each of trainee's client.
- Review and sign off on notes at minimum once per month.
- Provide case consultation and support to supervisee.
- Support trainee to think critically of ethical standards and considerations.
- Aid the trainee in utilizing ORS/SRS as a therapeutic tool in each session with clients.
- Help trainee identify possible interventions, approaches, and theories of change.
- Conduct progress reviews and final evaluations from trainee's program.
- Attend supervisors' meeting (dates and times TBD) every two months.
- Sign off on your trainee's BBS hours weekly.

#### Benefits:

- You can attend any and all of GHC trainings, conferences, meetings and in-services for FREE. Most trainings offer CEUs.
- Often times, supervisors report feeling rejuvenated and energized from supervising trainees. Students are new to the field; they tend to have a lot of energy and a fresh perspective.
- You're giving back to your community!

#### Qualifications:

- Two-years post-licensure, a LCSW, LMFT, LEP, LPCC through California Board of Behavioral Sciences (BBS).
- Completed six-hour CEU course on Clinical Supervision through BBS.
- Have liability insurance (this is in addition to GHC's, Dr. Nylund's, the trainee's, and the school program's liability insurance).
- Provide copies of three above-mentioned documents.
- Possess a basic understanding of Feedback Informed Treatment (FIT) and Narrative Therapy. (Training and support available for this.)
- Lived, personal or professional LGBTQ experience, and feel fairly competent and well versed in LGBTQ topics and identities.
- Value, passion and commitment for social, economic and racial justice.
